

Hilton, Marston on Dove and Hoon Neighbourhood Plan Referendum: Information Statement

This information statement is published by South Derbyshire District Council, as required by Regulation 4(1) of the Neighbourhood Planning (Referendums) Regulations 2012.

A Referendum in relation to the Hilton, Marston on Dove and Hoon Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Thursday 16 September 2021 between the hours of 7am and 10pm.

The question being asked at this referendum will be:

“Do you want South Derbyshire District Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Hilton, Marston on Dove and Hoon to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

A map of the Referendum area is provided.

A person is entitled to vote in the Referendum if on 16 September 2021:

- he or she is 18 years of age or over on the day of poll; and
- entitled to vote in a local government election in the Referendum area; and
- His or her qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area. A person's qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The Referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the Referendum is £2,722.55. This has been calculated by adding 5.9p for each of the 6,111 Local Government electors for the specific referendum area, at the time of publication of the notice of Referendum, to the base amount of £2,362.

This Referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures similar to those used at local government (District) Elections.
