## South Derbyshire Staker Lane Public Places Public Spaces Protection Order 2023



Notice is hereby given that South Derbyshire District Council ("the Council") has made the following Public Spaces Protection Order under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act"):

- 1. The Order may be cited as the South Derbyshire Staker Lane Public Spaces Protection Order and came into force on 27<sup>th</sup> January 2023 for a duration of 3 years.
- 2. This Order applies to all land described in the Schedule below (the 'designated land') being land in the area of the Council to which the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 applies and will be protected by the making of this Order.
- 3. No person shall have vehicular access to the land described in the Schedule except for access to the designated land for the purposes of cleaning, maintenance, emergency access and right of access to the privately owned field to the south of the designated land. Access rights shall be limited by the installation of one lockable gate which shall remain locked for 24 hours of the day other than to enable the permitted rights described in this Order.
- 4. There is no prohibition on pedestrian, equine or bicycle access onto the designated land.
- 5. Responsibility for the maintenance of the gate and the keeping of the key or access code lies with South Derbyshire District Council, Civic Offices, Civic Way, Swadlincote, DE11 0AH.

## **Penalty**

4. A person who is guilty of an offence under article 3 shall under section 67 of the Act be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or a fixed penalty notice of a fee set by the relevant Council Committee not exceeding a maximum of £100.


