## South Derbyshire Dogs on Lead Public Spaces Protection Order 2023



Notice is hereby given that South Derbyshire District Council ("the Council") has made the following Public Spaces Protection Order under section 59 of the Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime and Policing Act 2014 ("the Act"):

- 1. The Order may be cited as the South Derbyshire Dogs on Lead Public Places Public Spaces Protection Order and came into force on 27th January 2023 for a duration of 3 years.
- 2. This Order applies to all land specified in the Schedule.

## Offence

- 3. (1) A person in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if, at any time, on any land to which this Order applies he does not keep the dog on a lead, unless—
  - (a) he has a reasonable excuse for failing to do so; or
  - (b) the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to his failing to do so.
- (2) For the purposes of this article a person who habitually has a dog in his possession shall be taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog.

## **Penalty**

4. A person who is guilty of an offence under article 3 shall under section 67 of the Act be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or a fixed penalty notice of a fee set by the relevant Council Committee not exceeding a maximum of £100.
