

## Nil return and declaration for candidates at parish elections

This form is for candidates who have spent no money at a parish election. It contains both the spending return and declaration, so no separate declaration is required.

I declare that I have incurred no election spending and this return is complete and correct as required by law.

By incurring no election spending, I mean that neither I, nor any other person or organisation acting on my behalf, did any of the following to promote my candidacy during the regulated period (including on travel and living expenses):

- made payments
- made use of items, facilities or services that were provided for my use or benefit
- made use of items bought before the regulated period
- incurred spending but did not receive the invoice ("unpaid claims")
- incurred spending but did not make the payment ("disputed claims")

I understand that if I have incurred any election spending and not declared it, I require a court order to pay it.
