Why not spend a day of learning with your class in your local town centre?

These fun learning cross curriculum sessions cover aspects of geography, local history, citizenship, PSHE, science, art and technology are for KS1, KS2 & KS3 based around the built heritage of the town.

Mix and Match sessions (up to 2 hours per half day session).

Led or self led options (using the same resources unless stated otherwise) available. Sessions are outdoors, whatever the weather, apart from the Heritage Trail.

Costs: £120 per class for a 2 hour led session or £200 for a full day plus cost of room hire for the day at Sharpe's Pottery Museum or Swadlincote Town Hall.

The commercial and administrative centre for South Derbyshire, Swadlincote's cultural heritage is largely tied to the town's industrial past of clay manufacturing and coal mining. Many of the buildings or structures associated with the industries have been listed to help preserve the Town's historic identity. **Our sessions draw on the rich history-the people and the places-and offer the opportunity to learn more.**

Trail KS1/ KS2/ KS3 History, PHSE (Raising Aspirations)



Designed to enable young people to learn more about the achievements of individuals and businesses in our area plan how they can achieve their dreams and reach their potential. Options include making clay models of key Swadlincote buildings, using GPS devices to explore the trail outdoors, working on pupils' own plaques to plan and celebrate their potential achievements and an analysis of town centre timelines. Townscape Science: 'Rot or Repair'?

KS1/ KS2/ KS3 Science Hist



Pupils become 'building detectives', looking for evidence of decay and repair. Through practical activities and investigation explore materials used in buildings and the damage caused by animals, plants, humans and the weather. A British Science Association CREST accredited education activity.

KS2 Local History, ICT, Citizenship

Learn and practice interviewing and media skills and experience. Develop planning and communication skills and gain knowledge on local heritage. 5 Samsung Tablets are provided for the school to borrow to record and download their own footage.
