Orienteering

Experience the forest from a different perspective. Our expertly designed course is ideal for all. With a short, medium or long route, you are sure to find a course to suit your group. Both the short and medium courses are on a surfaced trail, suitable for wheelchairs.

Combat Archery

A high adrenaline team game that sees a crossover between archery and dodgeball. Dodge, duck and dive behind the inflatable barrier to avoid the foam tipped arrows coming from the opposing team (ages 11+ only).



Laser Combat

Find out who's the sharpest shooter, who's a born leader and who the tactical thinkers are whilst working through a number of game play scenarios with our top of the range Laser Tag equipment. This activity can be delivered within a woodland setting or flat grass area depending on accessibility requirements.



Sports & Games

Why not schedule a session that lets them choose from a variety of exciting activities? They can challenge friends with our **Giant Games like Jenga, Connect 4, or Chess.** Suit up for some laughs in our **Sumo Suits**, or get active with a range of sporting options including **rounders, cricket, dodgeball, crazy golf, boccia, and corn hole.** It's a great way to encourage choice, movement, and social interaction—all in one session.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What age groups are your programmes suitable for?

Our sessions are tailored for a range of age groups, from Key Stage 1 through to Key Stage 4. We'll adapt activities to suit the needs and abilities of your pupils.

2. How long do sessions last?

We offer flexible timings—from short sessions to full-day programmes. We'll work around your arrival and departure times to make the most of your visit.

3. What should pupils bring?

We recommend weather-appropriate clothing, sturdy closed toe footwear, a refillable water bottle, a packed lunch and any personal medication. We'll provide any specialist equipment needed for the selected activities.

4. Is the site accessible?

Yes! Rosliston Forestry Centre has accessible toilets, indoor classroom space, and pathways suitable for wheelchairs. Let us know any specific needs when booking.

5. Is there a secure space for students to store their belongings during the visit?

Yes. All bookings include mandatory room hire which provides a dedicated 'base camp' for your group. This room can be locked and used to safely store bags, packed lunches, and any other belongings throughout your visit.

6. Is there a space for us to have lunch?

Yes, depending on the weather, we'll make sure there's a suitable space for you to enjoy lunch comfortably.

7. What happens in bad weather?

Our programmes run in most weather conditions, but we have indoor space available and can adapt activities to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience.

8. Are risk assessments provided?

Yes, we provide full risk assessments for all activities and can support you with any documentation required for your school's policies.

9. Are the activity delivery staff qualified?

Absolutely. In line with South Derbyshire District Council's recruitment policy, all staff are fully qualified, Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checked, Safeguarding trained and First Aiders.

10. Do staff need to supervise activities?

Our trained facilitators lead all sessions, but we ask that school staff remain present to support behaviour and safeguarding.

11. How do we book?
