Q5. Please give details of why you consider the Local Plan is not legally compliant or is unsound or fails to comply with the duty to co-operate.

Residents consider PM21 to be legally non-compliant and unsound because it is not justified, is not effective and is not consistent with national policy.

Residents are concerned that PM21 converts what was previously a conditional requirement, dependent upon evidence demonstrating need, into a mandatory infrastructure requirement in the form of an all-traffic link road between the A516 and A38.

Residents are concerned that the Sustainability Appraisal does not appear to have properly assessed realistic alternatives to the proposed all-traffic corridor. The Council's own consultation material states that no reasonable alternatives have been identified. However residents consider that reasonable alternatives exist, including:

- development without an all-traffic A516-A38 link road;
- access arrangements capable of serving STRA2 without creating a strategic through route;
- alternative access configurations; and
- public transport, active travel and local access solutions that do not require a strategic all traffic corridor

Residents are therefore concerned that the proposed road has been selected without a proportionate assessment of reasonable alternatives.

The Council's own transport modelling indicates that congestion across the Derby Housing Market Area would increase by approximately 110-111% without mitigation, that the 'known mitigation' package already reduces impacts to approximately 53-54% and that the additional highway package, including the proposed link road, improves that overall figure to approximately 59% raising questions as to whether the proposed all traffic corridor is necessary as a mandatory infrastructure requirement.

Residents also note that the Council's own transport evidence indicates that the A38 remains the primary route into the proposed development. Residents therefore question why a mandatory all-traffic corridor between the A516 and A38 is required at all.

Residents are also concerned that PM21 changes a previously conditional policy position into a mandatory infrastructure requirement before the necessity of the route has been robustly demonstrated. The evidence does not presently demonstrate that the proposed all-traffic link road is necessary or proportionate as a mandatory infrastructure requirement for STRA2.

Residents further note that the updated Sustainability Appraisal and viability evidence relating to the proposed modifications were not available at the point the Environmental and Development Services Committee approved consultation on PM21 on the 5th March 2026. Residents consider that this reinforces concerns that the modification was not supported by a complete evidence base and that, at the time of writing, the necessity of the proposed road and the assessment of reasonable alternatives have still not been adequately demonstrated.

Residents further note that associated modifications acknowledge that the proposed road would dissect the Country Park. Residents are concerned that the evidence does not clearly demonstrate how the Country Park, Green Infrastructure and retained separation land would continue to perform their intended functions once divided by a strategic all-traffic road.

Residents wish to be clear that their concern is with the mandatory all traffic A516-A38 link road rather than the principle of the STRA2 allocation itself.

The Council's own transport evidence indicates that the A38 remains the primary route into the development and that the link road is not the principal means of access. Residents therefore consider that STRA2 is capable of being delivered through alternative access arrangements without a mandatory A516-A38 strategic corridor. The necessity of the road and the deliverability of the housing are separate questions and should be assessed separately.

Residents therefore consider that removal of the mandatory road requirement would not prevent delivery of the housing allocation and that the Council should demonstrate, through proportionate evidence and alternatives assessment, why the road is necessary before embedding it as a policy requirement.

Request respectfully request that PM21 be deleted. In the alternative, if the Inspector is not minded to delete PM21, the modification should be withdrawn and the Council should undertake a full assessment of reasonable alternatives, including options without an A516-A38 link road and options utilising alternative access arrangements before any revised proposal is subject to a full public consultation.

Q5. Please give details of why you consider the Local Plan is not legally compliant or is unsound or fails to comply with the duty to co-operate.

The Council's stated justification for PM16 relates to public transport connectivity and sustainable movement. However, the policy wording creates a general access connection, which is not restricted to bus access, but appears capable of facilitating a wider vehicular access arrangement. The supporting evidence does not clearly distinguish between these objectives and therefore the intended operational role, scale and function of the proposed A516 access remains uncertain.

The Council relies upon the design principles set out in the Design Midlands shaping streets review which promotes ideas relating to improved connectivity and sustainable movement public transport, walking and cycling and refers to a potential north south main street connection. However, residents note that this is a place-making and design document rather than a transport justification document. The conditional language used in Design Midlands review focuses on a 'potential Spine Road' and 'potential access points' and expressly finishes by stating that the 'illustration describes the strategic approaches discussed at the Design Review. It is not intended to fix these but highlight their potential for **further testing and development**'. Residents are concerned that PM16 **converts a potential design approach into a specific policy requirement** without clearly demonstrating:

- a) why this particular access arrangement is necessary;
- b) that the proposed A516 access is the only appropriate means of achieving the stated connectivity objectives; or
- c) that alternative approaches have been assessed

Residents therefore consider that PM16 has not been sufficiently justified by the evidence relied upon and its effectiveness has not been demonstrated through alternatives assessment and therefore it fails the test of soundness.

In the first instance residents respectfully request that PM16 be deleted so that any vehicular connection to the A516 associated with PM21 is first supported by robust evidence demonstrating its necessity.

Residents request that the Council undertake a proportionate assessment of reasonable alternatives and clearly demonstrate why the proposed access arrangement represents the most appropriate solution. The Council should also provide evidence demonstrating how the stated objectives of the modification, including public transport connectivity, sustainable movement and any wider planning benefits relied upon, are achieved through the proposed access arrangement and why alternative approaches would not achieve those objectives.

PM22

Q5. Please give details of why you consider the Local Plan is not legally compliant or is unsound or fails to comply with the duty to co-operate.

The PM22 map is insufficiently clear, inaccurate in certain respects and potentially misleading and therefore does not allow consultees to properly understand the proposed modifications, the function of the land shown on the map, the relationship between the various land use designations and the spatial implications of the proposals.

The PM22 Addendum Map (Appendix 1) forms a key part of the Regulation 19 consultation material. However, a number of important features are either unclear, insufficiently defined or inaccurately presented.

In particular:

- the mapping does not explain the purpose and meaning of the purple square symbols, requiring consultees to seek clarification from Council officers in order to understand their function. Residents who attended the public consultation on the 12th May 2026 were subsequently informed that these represented electricity pylons. However, concerns remain regarding the accuracy and presentation of those features. If the symbols are intended to represent existing physical infrastructure, consultees would reasonably expect them to be shown in locations that broadly correspond with their position on the ground. The PM22 mapping does not clearly achieve this.
- the distinction between Country Park land, Green Infrastructure, formal recreation provision and retained separation land is unclear;
- the removal of the Distance A and Distance B annotations from the PM22 mapping, reduces the ability of consultees to understand the function of the retained land between Burnaston village and the proposed development. Whilst the retained land remains shaded green on the amended map, the removal of those annotations, together with the increasing overlap between Country Park, Green Infrastructure and formal recreation provision, makes it more difficult to understand its role within the wider STRA2 framework. Residents support the retention of this land as open land and consider that it performs an important settlement separation, countryside transition and anti-coalescence function, contributing to the openness and rural setting of Burnaston and helping maintain a clear distinction between Burnaston village, the Pastures Estate and the wider STRA2 allocation;
- residents note that the explanatory text accompanying AM73 anticipates some more limited development fronting the A516. This appears to represent a material spatial change to the distribution of development within the allocation from the original Regulation 19 indicative map. However, neither PM22 nor the supporting evidence clearly explains the planning rationale for this change, identifies the scale, extent, density or form of that development, or explains how it relates to the wider Green Infrastructure and Country Park framework. Consultees are therefore unable to properly understand the implications of this element of the proposal or provide fully informed representations upon it during the consultation process;
- the purpose and meaning of the blue lines on the map labelled 'corridors' are not clearly explained and the legend itself is ambiguous, referring to 'pedestrian/cycle connections Blue' whilst depicting a pink route, making it unclear whether the blue corridor features and pedestrian/cycle connections are intended to represent different functions or the same network;
- important spatial relationships between an existing residential property, proposed infrastructure and surrounding land uses are difficult to interpret.

Residents raised concerns regarding the clarity and interpretation of PM22 shortly after the commencement of the public consultation and again during the final consultation event. Those concerns were acknowledged by the Council during the consultation period. However, residents remain concerned that the PM22 mapping was not corrected or republished during the consultation process. In particular, concerns were raised regarding the presentation of a sensitive residential receptor and its associated residential curtilage, comprising approximately four acres of private residential land, which was visually merged into the surrounding land and did not appear to be clearly identified or distinguished from surrounding Country Park and Green Infrastructure. Residents raised this issue during the consultation process and Council officers subsequently acknowledged concerns regarding the presentation of the property on the PM22 mapping. The property (Whitehaven) had previously been identified on the original published plan (Appendix 2). This omission created uncertainty regarding boundaries, separation distances, the distinction between private and public land; the proximity of the proposed link road and the relationship between the property and proposed recreation uses.

Residents therefore consider that these issues are not merely cartographic concerns but relate directly to consultation clarity, interpretation of the proposals and the ability of consultees to provide informed representations and fair public engagement.

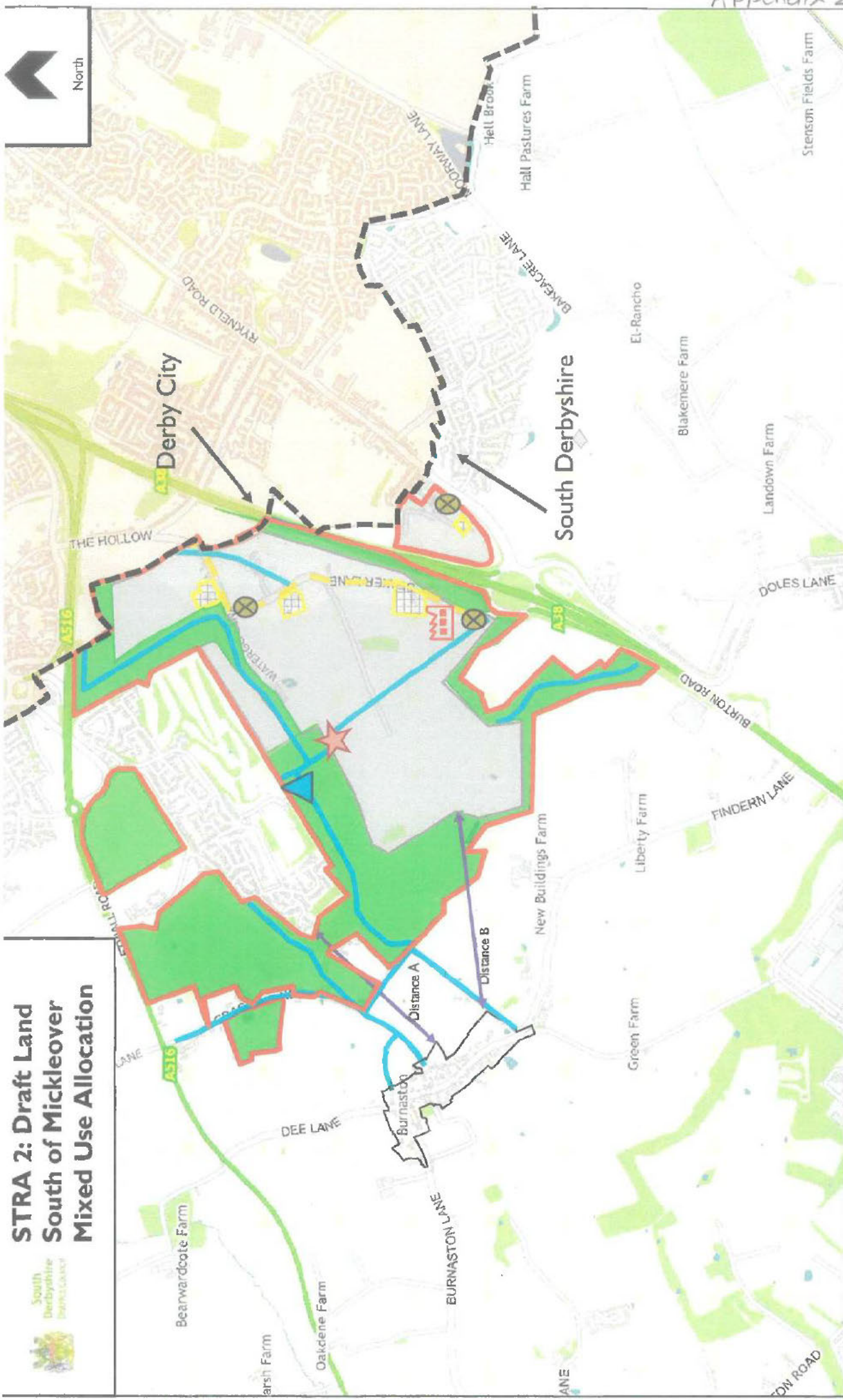

Residents respectfully request that PM22 is amended to provide a clearer and more comprehensively annotated plan showing the purpose, extent and function of all proposed land use designations, corridors and infrastructure.

The revised plan should:

- provide a clear and intelligible legend explaining all symbols, annotations and corridor features;
- clearly identify the purpose and function of the purple square symbols and ensure that their location accurately reflects the position of the features they are intended to represent;
- clearly identify the purpose and function of the blue corridor features;
- distinguish clearly between Country Park land, Green Infrastructure, formal recreation provision, retained separation land and development land;
- clearly communicate the settlement separation, countryside transition and openness functions of retained land between Burnaston village, the Pastures Estate and the wider STRA2 allocation;
- accurately identify existing residential properties and associated residential curtilage and clearly demonstrate the relationship between existing residential properties, proposed infrastructure, public access corridors and the proposed link road; and
- provide sufficient information to allow consultees to understand the proposed modifications and submit informed representations.

Q5. Please give details of why you consider the Local Plan is not legally compliant or is unsound or fails to comply with the duty to co-operate.

Residents consider AM73 to be unsound because it is not justified and is not effective.

Residents support the principle that, if formal sports provision is to be accommodated within STRA2, it should be concentrated within a single sports hub adjacent to Mickleover FC and the golf course rather than dispersed across the wider site. This is a more Green Infrastructure-sensitive approach, allows accessibility for both new and existing communities and is preferable to the dispersal of sports provision into the southern and south-western parts of the site. Residents also recognise that the proposed sports hub location was historically used as playing fields associated with Derby Grammar School and support the principle of a Community Use Agreement.

The South Derbyshire Local Plan Part 1 Review 2022-2041 C (vii) states that the new development will contribute towards existing deficiencies in the availability of sports and recreation facilities and will meet that demand through the provision of on-site facilities and/or additional capacity off site. The level and nature of any provision will be informed by a robust evidence base including the Built Facilities Strategy, Playing Pitch Strategy and other relevant needs assessment. Policy C (viii) states that built development within Green Infrastructure locations should be restricted to that ancillary to and necessary to support Green Infrastructure (GI).

The Playing Pitch Strategy identifies existing sporting deficiencies across South Derbyshire, however the evidence base does not clearly explain how those identified deficiencies translate into the scale, nature and extent of formal sports provision proposed within the STRA2 sports hub.

The Playing Pitch Strategy also emphasises the Sport England principles of Protect, Enhance and Provide. Residents are therefore concerned that, while the evidence identifies district sporting needs and deficiencies, it does not clearly explain what consideration was given to protecting and enhancing existing facilities before identifying the need for a sports hub within STRA2.

The Playing Pitch Strategy identifies rugby union shortfalls associated with Melbourne Sports Park, deficiencies in 3G AGP provision and cricket shortfalls across multiple locations within South Derbyshire. The Council has not clearly demonstrated:

- what consideration was given to protecting and enhancing existing facilities before identifying the need for a sports hub within STRA2;
- why enhancement was insufficient; and
- the scale, nature and extent of sports provision proposed within the STRA2 sports hub

Residents are also concerned that neither the policy nor the supporting material clearly limit how far formal recreation uses could spread beyond the intended sports hub. If AM73 intends sports provision to be focused in a single sports hub, the policy should include safeguards ensuring that formal sports provision and associated infrastructure remain contained within that hub. The Council's Active Wellbeing Strategy recognises the importance of walking, cycling, green spaces and informal physical activity in supporting health and wellbeing. Residents are therefore concerned that formal sports provision and associated infrastructure should not expand into land intended to perform openness and countryside functions.

Through workshops, public engagement events and informal meetings with the Council, residents have consistently raised concerns regarding the location, scale and intensity of formal sports provision and associated infrastructure particularly the potential for expansion beyond a single centralised sports hub and into the retained south western land: including through a petition signed by local residents and other interested parties in February 2026.

However, illustrative masterplan material and vision documents (Appendix 3) produced by the site promoters, Parker Strategic Land, has shown:

- a sports area adjacent to the development as indicated by AM73;
- a second sports area much further south-west of the site;
- sports uses extending towards the countryside edge in the south and south-west;
- recreation land spread across a wider area rather than confined to a single hub

Therefore whilst the emerging policy refers to a 'single sports hub', the promoters' own illustrative masterplan appears capable of delivering a broader and more dispersed pattern of recreation provision.

Residents' concerns are therefore not speculative. Neither the original Regulation 19 policy wording nor the AM73 modification clearly defines the extent, scale or intensity of formal sports provision, including the number and location of pitches, associated infrastructure or the level of organised sporting activity that may be accommodated within or beyond the intended sports hub. Nor does the policy provide sufficient safeguards to ensure that Country Park land, Green Infrastructure and undeveloped open land intended to remain outside the built development area, are not progressively incorporated into formal sports provision and associated infrastructure over time. Without clear policy safeguards and limits, programmed recreation could gradually extend beyond the defined sports hub and materially alter:

- openness;
- settlement distinction;
- countryside character;
- settlement separation; and
- the wider rural setting of Burnaston including retained separation land in the south-south west of the site (between Pastures Estate Swan Hill side and Burnaston village)

Residents also note that local ecological records compiled over a number of years (Appendix 4) identify protected and priority species associated with farmland, hedgerow and transitional habitats within the southern and south-western STRA2 land. Whilst these records are not presented as a formal ecological survey, they provide evidence of the ecological function and biodiversity interest of retained the land. Residents therefore consider that the role of the retained south-western land extends beyond recreation and visual amenity and includes important Green Infrastructure and habitat functions which should be taken into account when considering the scale, location and operational intensity of formal recreation provision and associated infrastructure.

This appendix is provided as contextual ecological information relevant to the evolving STRA2 Green Infrastructure (GI), Country Park and formal recreation proposals.

The material has been compiled by local residents over a multi-year period and has been submitted to relevant ecological/wildlife recording bodies. These records are not presented as a formal ecological survey or professional ecological assessment, but rather as evidence of the observed ecological function and biodiversity interest associated with parts of the southern and south western areas of the STRA 2 allocation.

This material is relevant insofar as the eventual operational form, intensity and long term management regime of retained land may materially influence:

Includes protected and priority species records associated with farmland, hedgerow and transitional habitats within the southern/south-western STRA 2 land.

THE VISION

Parker Strategic Land believes that the Land to the South of Mickleover provides a great opportunity for the delivery of new homes, community benefits and high quality environmental aspirations.

The aim of the vision should be to create an exemplary new neighbourhood that is seamlessly connected to the wider Derby conurbation but is also as self-sustaining as possible. The site is well located to help grow the urban area in an alternative and sustainable way. In doing so, it should also define an attractive and sensitive new edge to the urban area with park spaces, naturalistic landscapes, and new publicly accessible route ways.

Parker Strategic Land (PSL) have the ability and desire to deliver the central part of 'Core' of this masterplan vision. This would then allow the remainder of the vision to be delivered in a logical and sensible way by other landowners and developers.
