Assistance for local sports people

Active South Derbyshire, in partnership with South Derbyshire District Councils Active Communities and Health team and Active Nation, offer a system of support aimed at encouraging the development of sporting excellence in South Derbyshire.

The Scheme is designed to provide assistance to talented local sports people, so that they can better realise their potential at county, regional, national and international levels.

Depending on their level of achievement to date, individual applicants will be eligible for one or all of the following:

- 1. The provision of a Sports Pass, which allows free use of certain sports facilities for training purposes at Green Bank and Etwall Leisure Centre's.**
- 2. A small financial grant for training and coaching expenses, travel costs or the purchase of specialist equipment (ranging from £60-£100). PLEASE NOTE – due to a vast increase in applications into the scheme, County level athletes who successfully apply will now only be awarded with a free Sports Pass.**

Conditions

1. Applicants must have been selected for representative honours at County, Regional, National or International level in the past 12 months. Applicants must have competed at the level they have been selected for prior to making this application (school representation is excluded from this scheme).
2. Applicants must live or go to school within the District of South Derbyshire or represent /attend a sports club based in the District of South Derbyshire.
3. Assistance is available to sports people of all ages who meet the stated criteria.
4. Applicants must have amateur status.
5. Applicants must be competing in sports recognised by Sport England.
6. The Sports Pass is only valid for use at Green Bank and Etwall Leisure Centre's, and then at the discretion of the Manager.
7. Clubs or whole teams are not eligible for assistance; the scheme is for individual sports people.
8. The level of award is at the discretion of Active South Derbyshire.
9. Recipients of a Sports Pass and Sports Grant will be willing and available for promotional purposes such as public appearances, press calls etc.
10. The Sports Pass is valid for 12 months from the date of issue.

Please note that applications are considered twice a year; with deadlines annually on the **1st February** and the **1st August**. If your application is submitted after one of these deadlines, it will only be considered in the following round of funding.
